While the food scene in Murphys offers delicious local, farm fresh fare, some like to plan a picnic when getting outdoors. <u>Sierra Hills Market and Natural Food Store</u> next door is the perfect stop for any foodie planning a picnic. Be sure to stock up on extra beverages to stay hydrated at the higher elevations. While Murphys sits at 2400 foot elevation, a day trip to hike or play in Arnold will put you at 4000 foot elevation quickly.

Call ahead! <u>Sierra Nevada Adventure Company</u> in Arnold provides a variety of rentals from Kayaks to Stand Up Paddle Boards. It is best to call ahead to learn about options and availability before making the drive up the mountain from Murphys.



Calling all History Buffs to Murphys this Fall!

History tours at <u>Ironstone Vineyards</u> are guided estate tours that explore the property's Gold Rush-era history and its connection to the family's agricultural legacy. The tour typically includes visits to the iconic Tasting Room, the outdoor gold mining museum, the wine production facility, and the impressive wine caverns. To connect with some of the oldest land owners in the Calaveras Wine Scene, be sure to visit Stu and Dolores at <u>Brice Station Vineyards</u>, a short drive up highway four In Murphys.

Enjoy their award-winning wines and tour the working winery while peeking at their outdoor amphitheater.

A visit to the <u>Angels Camp Museum</u> is a must do for any history buff. Just a 15-20 minute drive down the hill from Murphys. The incredible collections that sprawl the back side of the museum are truly hidden gems. Plan to visit for at least an hour or two with so much to take in. Bring a picnic to enjoy at their outdoor spaces if you wish.
